

Baby Akorn by DROPS Design

Knitted baby hat with cables. Sizes 0 months – 4 years. The piece is worked in DROPS Puna.

DROPS Design: Pattern no pu-001-by

Yarn group B

Sizes: 0/1 - 1/3 - 6/9 - 12/18 months (2 - 3/4) years

Fits head size: approx. 34/38 - 40/42 - 42/44 - 44/46 (48/50 -

50/52) cm Materials:

DROPS PUNA from Garnstudio (belongs to yarn group B) 50-50-50 (50-50) g colour 02, beige

The piece can also be knitted with yarn from: "Alternative yarn (Yarn group B)" – see link below.

DROPS DOUBLE POINTED NEEDLES SIZE 4 MM – or the size needed to get 21 stitches and 28 rows stocking stitch on 10 cm in width and 10 cm in height.

DROPS CABLE NEEDLE – for cables.

Pattern for DROPS Baby 31-1

INFORMATION FOR THE PATTERN:

PATTERN:

See diagrams A.1 and A.2. Choose diagram for your size.

HAT:

The piece is worked in the round with double pointed needles. Cast on 72-84-84-96 (96-108) stitches with double pointed needles size 4 mm and Puna. Work A.1a (= 12 stitches) over all stitches (= 6-7-7-8 (8-9) times in width). When A.1a has been completed 1 time in height, work

A.1b over A.1a. Continue like this. REMEMBER THE KNITTING TENSION! When the piece measures approx, 10-11-12-12 (12-13) cm, adjust to after a whole repeat of A.1b in height, work A.2 over A.1b (there are now approx. 4-4-4-5 (5-5) cm left). When A.2 has been worked 1 time in height, there are 24-28-28-32 (32-36) stitches on the needles. Knit together all stitches 2 and 2 on the next 2 rounds (= a total of 2 times) = 6-7-7-8 (8-9) stitches. Cut the strand and pull it through the remaining stitches. Pull tight and fasten well. The hat measures approx. 14-15-16-17 (17-18) cm.








Diagram for DROPS Baby 31-1
