

FLUX HAT

Designed for Urth Yarns

Materials: 1 skein Urth Uneek Worsted

Size: Adult - 21" diameter, 9" from brim to

crown not including pompom

Needles: US 8 16" circular for body of hat

US 8 DPNs for crown of hat

Notions: 3" Pompom maker

Tapestry Needle Stitch Marker

Gauge: 23 sts x 28 rows in k1, p1 rib = 4"

square

Abbreviations:

BO - Bind off

CO - Cast on

EOR - End of Round

K - Knit

P-Purl

PM - Place Marker

Rep - Repeat

Sts - Stitches

YO - Yarn Over

Pattern Notes:

The hat is knit in the round using a long tail cast on and a series of decreases at the crown.

Pattern:

Using a long tail cast on, CO 76 sts, pm.

Round 1: *P1, k1* to end.

Round 2-8: Rep Round 1

Round 9 - 62: *Yo, K2tog* to EOR (76 sts)

Round 63 - 64: *K2tog* to EOR (38 sts, 19 sts)

Round 65: K2, *k2tog* to EOR (10 sts)

Cut yarn leaving 12" tail, feed tail through rem sts, pull to close.





Finishing:

Secure tail at crown of hat on the inside of the hat using the tapestry needle. Pull tail back through to RS on top of hat.

Do not cut yarn, it will be used to secure the pompom.

Weave in remaining end on brim using a tapestry needle to weave it in vertically along the knit column on the inside of the hat.

Make 3" pompom with left over yarn.

Sew pompom to top of hat using yarn tail.

Wash per ball band instructions
