



## LENA COWL

designed by Irina Poludnenko



**SIZE** One Size

### KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

42" circumference x 11" wide/106.5 x 28cm

### MATERIALS

- 1 ball EACH S. Charles Collezione LUNA 71% kid mohair, 20% silk, 9% lurex (0.88oz/25g; 232yds/212.5m) in **colors #23 stormy skies (A), #25 blue moon (B), #22 champagne fizz (C), #24 twilight (D) and #26 sunbeam (E)**
- One #10 (6 mm) long circular needle
- OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**
- Yarn needle

### GAUGE

12 sts and 16 rows = 4"/10 cm in Open Star Pattern, using 2 strands of yarn held together

**TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE**

### PATTERN STITCH

**Open Star Pattern (multiple of 3 sts)**

**Row 1 (WS):** K2, \*yo, k3, with tip of left-hand needle, pass first st of k3 over last 2 stitches and off needle; repeat from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 2:** Knit.

**Row 3:** K1, \*k3, with tip of left-hand needle, pass first stitch of k3 over last 2 stitches and off needle, yo; repeat from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 4:** Knit.

Rep Rows 1-4 for Open Star Pattern.

### Open Star Stripe Sequence

\*Working in Open Star Pattern, and using 2 strands of yarn held together, work 2 rows each in A, B, C, D, then E; repeat from \* for number of stripes indicated.

**NOTE:** Two strands of yarn are held together throughout. Circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches.

### COWL

With A, cast on 108 sts loosely.

Begin Open Star Pattern and Stripe Sequence in rows until piece measures 11" from beginning (total 5 Stripe Sequences).

Bind off loosely in pattern.

### FINISHING

With wrong sides facing, sew short ends of piece together. Weave in ends.
