



Knitted DROPS hat in 2 threads "Eskimo", worked from side to side. Yarn alternative 1 thread "Polaris".

" - A simple hat is a must in any wardrobe. As useful on the slopes as in the city."

Size: S - M - L

Circumference: approx 54 - 56 - 58 cm [21¼" - 22" - 22¾"]

Materials: DROPS Eskimo from Garnstudio
150-200-200 g color no 23, tan

Yarn alternative to 2 threads Eskimo:
1 thread DROPS Polaris
100% pure new wool, 100 g = 36 meters

Single pointed needles size 10 mm [US 15] – or size needed to get
9 sts x 18 rows in garter st = 10 x 10 cm [4" x 4"].

There are different terms for crocheting in British and American English.*

Pattern:

Garter st, back and forth on needle: K all rows.

Hat: Worked from side to side back and forth on needle. Cast on 26-27-28 sts on needle size 10 mm [US 15] with 2 threads Eskimo. Work garter st – see above- at the same time continue as follows: * 2 rows on all sts, 2 rows on the first 21 sts, 2 rows on the first 16 sts *, repeat from *-*. Bind off when piece measures 52-54-56 cm [20½"-21¼"-22"], where longest.

Assembly: Sew tog cast on row and bind off row. Sew a thread through sts at the top of hat and tighten to form the top.

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
