



COTTON CLASSIC STITCH SAMPLE PULLOVER

INTERMEDIATE

SIZES Small (**Medium**, Large, **X-Large**)

KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

Bust 36 (40, 44, 48)"/91.5 (101.5, 112, 122) cm

Length 22½ (23, 23½, 24)"/57 (58.5, 60, 61) cm

MATERIALS

• 8 (9, 10, 11) skeins Tahki Yarns

COTTON CLASSIC 100% mercerized cotton (1.75oz/50g; 108yds/100m) in **color #3702 chartreuse**

• One pair size 6 (4mm) needles **OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**

- Crochet hook size F-5 (3.75mm) for Edging
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle

GAUGES

20 sts and 26 rows = 4"/10 cm in Stockinette stitch

18 sts and 28 rows = 4"/10 cm in Miniature Leaf pattern

20 sts = 4"/10 cm wide and 3 pattern reps = 3"/7.5cm tall in Horseshoe pattern

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGES

PATTERN STITCHES

Stockinette stitch (St st)

K on RS, p on WS.

K3, p2 rib (multiple of 5 sts + 6)

Row 1 (RS) K2, p2, * k3, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2 Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts as they face you.

Repeat Rows 1-2 for k3, p2 rib.

Reverse Single Crochet (Rev sc)

Horseshoe pat (multiple of 10 sts + 1)

Rows 1 and 3 (WS) Purl.

Row 2 K1, * yo, k3, sl 1-k2tog-*psso*, k3, yo, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 4 P1, * k1, yo, k2, sl 1-k2tog-*psso*, k2, yo, k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rows 5 and 7 K1, * p9, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 6 P1, * k2, yo, k1, sl 1-k2tog-*psso*, k1, yo, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 8 P1, * k3, yo, sl 1-k2tog-*psso*, yo, k3, p1; rep from * to end.

Repeat Rows 1-8 for Horseshoe pat.

Miniature Leaf pat (multiple of 6 sts + 2)

Rows 1 and 3 (WS) Purl.

Row 2 K1, * k3, yo, sl 1-k2tog-*psso*, yo; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 4 K1, * yo, sl 1-k2tog-*psso*, yo, k3; rep from * to last st, k1.

Repeat Rows 1-4 for Miniature Leaf pat.

BACK

Cast on 91 (101, 111, 121) sts.

(WS) Begin Horseshoe pat; work 24 rows (3 repeats).

Purl 1 row.

(RS) Change to k3, p2 rib; work 9", end with a WS row.

(RS) Knit 1 row, dec 1 st – 90 (100, 110, 120) sts.

Continue in St st; work even until piece measures 14" from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Armholes

(RS) Bind off 5 (5, 6, 6) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st at each end of every RS row 5 (6, 7, 8) times – 70 (78, 84, 92) sts rem.

Work even until Armholes measure 7½ (8, 8½, 9)" from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Shoulders

(RS) Bind off 6 (7, 7, 8) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 5 (6, 7, 8) sts at beg of next 4 rows – 38 (40, 42, 44) sts rem. Bind off all sts.

FRONT

Work as for BACK until piece measures 14½" from beg, end with a WS row; pm between center sts.

Shape Neck

(RS) Continuing with Armhole shaping, work to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, join a second ball of yarn, k2tog–tbl, work to end.

Working both sides at the same time, dec 1 st at Neck edge every RS row 18 (19, 20, 21) more times – 16 (19, 21, 24) sts rem.

Work even until piece measures same as BACK to Shoulder shaping.

Shape Shoulders

Work as for BACK.

SLEEVES

Cast on 50 (50, 56, 56) sts..

(WS) Begin Miniature Leaf pattern; work 10 rows.

Shape Sleeve

(WS) Continuing in Miniature Leaf pattern, inc 1 st each side every 10th row 6 (7, 6, 7) times total – 62 (64, 68, 70) sts.

Work even until piece measures 12 (12½, 13, 13½)" from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Cap

(RS) Keeping in pattern, bind off 5 (5, 6, 6) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st at each end every RS row 15 times – 22 (24, 26, 28) sts rem.

(RS) Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 4 rows – 6 (8, 10, 12) sts rem. Bind off all sts.

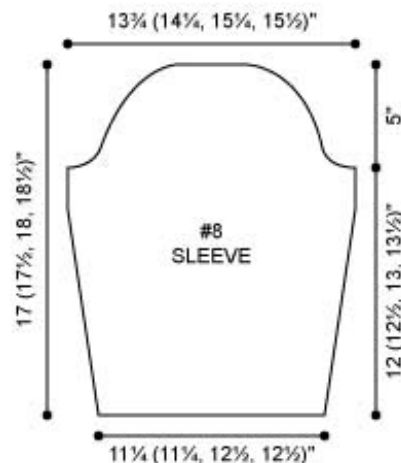
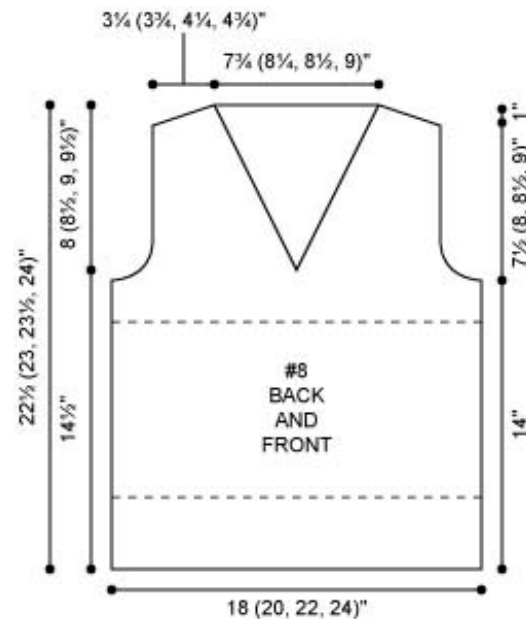
FINISHING

Block pieces to measurements. Sew Shoulder

seams. Set in SLEEVES; sew side and Sleeve seams.

Neck Edging

With RS facing, beg at back of Neck and using crochet hook, work 1 row of Rev sc around entire Neck edge. Weave in ends.
