



Harvest Bella Cowl

Designed for Urth Yarns

Materials: 1 skein Urth Harvest
Worsted
Needles: US Size 8 48" circular
Notions: Stitch Marker
Tapestry Needle
Gauge: 12 sts x 16 rows in Mesh
Stitch =4" square

Abbreviations:

BO - Bind off
EOR - End of Round
K - Knit
K2tog - Knit 2 stitches together
Pssso - Pass slipped stitch over
PM - Place marker
Rep - Repeat
Rnd - Round
S - Slip
SM - Slip marker
Sts - Stitches
YO - Yarn over

Special Stitch Pattern:

Mesh Stitch

Round 1: * K2tog, yo *

Round 2: Repeat Round 1

Pattern Notes:

When casting on, count only the stitches cast onto the needle, not those which are cast onto the cable of the circular needle. The total number of stitches to be worked will be twice the number cast onto the needle plus the slip knot which is knit together with the first stitch.

If you find it difficult to begin with the Mesh Stitch round 1 as presented, knit a single setup round then begin the Mesh Stitch.

When creating the i-cord bind off, after passing all sts back to the left needle, give the yarn a gentle tug to even out the tension on the three sts which form the icord



**Pattern:**

Using a mobius cast on, cast on 85 sts. See Pattern Notes.

PM and join to work in the round with a single cross in the cable itself.

Rnd 1-46: Rep rnds 1-2 in Mesh Stitch Pattern

Rnd 47: Knit

CO 4 sts using cable cast on

Slip 4 sts back to left needle

Row 1: Knit 3, s1, k1, pssso, return 4 sts to left needle

Rep row 1 until all stitches are cast off.

Finishing:

Using a tapestry needle, graft the last four sts of the i-cord to the first four.

Weave in all ends.

Wet block or steam block your cowl and enjoy.
