DROPS crochet slippers in double thread "Alpaca".

Size:

5/6½ - 7½/9 - 9½/10½ (US sizes)
 35/37 - 38/40 - 41/43 (EU sizes)
 Foot length: 8.75"-9½"-10.6" (22-24-27 cm)

Materials:

DROPS Alpaca from Garnstudio
 100-100-100 g color no 6347, grey-purple
 and use: a remnant color no 01 white DROPS Cotton Viscose also
 from Garnstudio

DROPS crochet hook size US E/4 (3.5 mm) - or size needed to obtain
 18 dc x 8 rows with 2 threads Alpaca = 4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm).

DROPS pearl buttons, no 541, 4 pcs.

Note: This pattern is written in American English.
 There are different terms for crocheting in British and American English.

Crochet info: Replace first dc on round/row with 3 ch. Finish each round with 1 sl st in 3rd ch from beg of round.
 Finish each row with 1 sl st in ch from beg of previous row.

Decreasing tip:

Dec as follows at beg of row: replace 1 dc with 1 ch
 Dec as follows at the end of row: Turn piece when number of dc to be dec remains and work return row.

Increasing tip: Inc by working 2 dc in 1 dc.

Slipper: Crochet from toe towards the heel. Crochet 3 ch and form a ring with 1 sl st in first ch.

Round 1: 8 dc in ring - see Crochet info!
 Round 2: 2 dc in each dc = 16 dc.

Round 3: * 1 dc in first dc, 2 dc in next dc*, repeat from *-* = 24 dc
Round 4: * 1 dc in each of the first 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc*, repeat from *-* = 32 dc.
On next round inc 2-6-2 dc evenly = 34-38-42 dc.
Continue in the round with 1 dc in each dc until piece measures 3½"-4"-4.4" (9-10-11 cm).
Now work 30-34-38 dc, turn the piece (do not crochet the last 4 sts = opening mid upper foot).
Continue back and forth, at the same time dec 1 dc each side on first row – see Decreasing tip = 28-32-36 dc.
Work 1 dc in each dc until piece measures 5½"-6.2"-7½" (14-16-19 cm). Now inc 1 dc each side on every other row a total of 3 times – see Increasing tip = 34-38-42 dc.
When piece measures 8.7"-9½"-10.6" (22-24-27 cm) fold it double and crochet slipper tog mid back with a row of sl sts through both layers. Cut the thread and fasten.

Border: Crochet a row of sc with 2 threads Alpaca round the opening (crochet approx 2 sc in each dc).
Cut the thread. Change to 2 threads Cotton Viscose and continue as follows: 1 sc mid back in first sc, * 3 ch, 1 dc in the first ch, skip 1 sc, 1 sc in next dc*, repeat from *-* and finish with 1 sl st in first sc.

Strap: Crochet 6 ch with 2 threads Alpaca. Work 1 dc in the 4th ch from hook (= 2 dc) and 1 dc in each of the last 2 ch = 4 dc. Work 1 dc in each dc – remember Crochet info – until strap measures 4" (10 cm).
Cut the thread and fasten. Sew strap to slipper with 1 pearl button each side – buttons are for decoration only.

DROPS ALPACA

An extremely soft and versatile 100% pure wool from the alpacas in South America. The filaments in alpaca wool are 3 times stronger and have an insulating capacity 7 times that of ordinary lambs wool. Creates very warm and cosy garments, the delicate cloud of filaments making it almost silky and very soft to touch. Very easy to handle and a lovely wool to knit as stitches glide along the needle effortlessly..

100% alpaca wool, 50g = 80m
Needle size US 3-4 (3-3.5mm)
Gauge: 23 sts x 30 rows = 4"x4"
